# ARRANGEMENTS FOR PONY SALE DAY

The 2024 Sale is run under the auspices of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society. Transfers of ownership will be processed on the day of sale and the  $\pm 20$  transfer fee is payable by the buyer along with the sale price for the pony/ponies purchased.

# PURCHASE OF PONIES

- Transfers of ownership will be processed on the day and the £20 transfer fee is payable by the buyer on the day when the pony is paid for.
- Registered buyers must go to sales office to pay and collect passports.
- For online buyers, we would prefer to take payments over the phone but it is also possible, if local, to pay at the mart after the sale is finished and collect your passport and pony.
- Ponies can be collected after the sale is completed once payment has been made.

# ONLINE BUYING

- Go to <u>https://auction.anmarts.co.uk</u> and click on the sale you wish to buy from. (There is also a link from the viewing sale page.)
- Click on the Bid on this Auction button to register
- Online Buyers MUST BE contactable by phone immediately following the sale in order for payments to be taken. Ponies cannot leave the mart until they are paid for in full.

# PASSPORTS

Passports and microchips for ponies will be checked at the Sale. Vendors, please ensure that you contact a "checker" immediately upon arrival at the sale to have your ponies' passports checked, prior to handing your passports to the market office. It is the responsibility of the vendor or any person acting on his/her behalf to ensure that this is carried out. <u>\*Please Note\* Passports and microchips of all ponies will be checked</u> by officials. Should a microchip be untraceable or passport incorrect, the pony will not be permitted to go through the ring.

No pony will be sold unless it has been entered into the sale adhering to the conditions of entry/guidelines.

# <u>SHIPPING</u>

Buyers must pay for their SHIPPING SPACE at the auction mart office at the time of purchase of ponies. The 2024 rates are as follows: Total Cost Lerwick Mart to Aberdeen Pier =  $\pm$ 19.00 Plus Vat. Total Cost Lerwick Mart to Thainstone =  $\pm$ 32.25 Plus Vat

# **IMPORTANT**

Buyers are reminded that any ponies they purchase are at their risk at the fall of the hammer. No undertaking of the auctioneers or their servants to take charge of any lots after the sale or to forward them to their destination shall be held to impose upon the auctioneers any legal obligation. Whilst every effort is made by Pony Breeders of Shetland Association (PBSA), Shetland Livestock Marketing Group (SLMG) and Aberdeen and Northern Marts (ANM) to ensure that the information given regarding pedigree, ownership, detail of colour and date of birth is correct, the responsibility remains with the prospective buyers to verify these details. # ADDITIONAL SHIPPING INFORMATION FOR ONLINE BUYERS

Please remember that it is the responsibility of the online buyer to arrange their own transport from the pier in Aberdeen for their pony/s onward journey. This transport needs to be ready to pick up the pony/s from the Aberdeen pier first thing on the morning of arrival from Shetland (weather permitting – Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October). Transport from Aberdeen pier to Thainstone mart can be arranged at time of payment in Lerwick. Lairage can be arranged at Thainstone by contacting them directly Tel. (01467) 623710.

This sale includes an online buying facility courtesy of Aberdeen & Northern Marts, Online Auction. A refundable fee is charged for signing up to bid as a security measure against bogus bidders. An online buyer's fee of 1% plus VAT is added to the price of ponies. # CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/ GUIDELINES FOR THE SALE OF PEDIGREE SHETLAND PONIES

- 1. This sale is run under the auspices of the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society (SPS-BS) and the show is affiliated to the SPS-BS.
- 2. Ponies must be the bone fide property of the vendor at time of entry and must be registered in their name with the SPS-BS and if castrated must be correctly registered as a gelding.
- Vendors <u>must</u> be fully paid up Members of the PBSA to be eligible to enter ponies in the Select Sale.
- 4. Once entered it is understood that ponies will be forward for the sale. Any vendor withdrawing stock from the sale without a valid reason or vet's certificate will be fined £100 per pony. If the fine is not paid, then the vendor will be unable to enter ponies into subsequent sales.
- 5. Ponies must not be removed from pens or handled without the vendor or his/ her representative being present.
- 6. At all Sales, if the vendor is not present in person, a representative must be nominated in advance who will be responsible for the ponies.
- 7. All stock must be registered with the SPS-BS. The deadline for foal passport applications is 31<sup>st</sup> July.
- 8. The minimum age of foals to be sold is eighteen weeks on the day of the Sale even if being sold at foot. The foal's exact date of birth must be stated on the entry form.
- 9. It must be emphasised that foals, unless being sold at foot, must be living independently, weaned and able to eat hard food.
- 10. No ponies will be accepted for sale if they have undergone any form of surgical procedure e.g. castration, within 4 weeks of the sale date.
- 11. Vendors who have had ponies suffering from an infectious disease within six weeks of the Sale must not present any ponies for sale. Any ponies showing symptoms of an infectious disease such as coughing, swollen glands, high temperature or a muco-purulent nasal discharge (snotty nose) will be excluded from the Sale.
- 12. The sale organisers reserve the right to call out a Veterinary Surgeon, at the vendors cost, should the need arise.
- 13. The sale organisers reserve the right to refuse to offer for sale any equine that the welfare officer or veterinary surgeon deems to be too young or unfit in any way.
- 14. When a pony goes through the sale ring wearing a head collar or bridle, the animal must be left with a head collar after it is sold, but not necessarily the one it was sold with. When a pony goes through the sale ring without a head collar, it would be sold on that understanding.

- 15. Any ponies over the age of eighteen years must have a Vet's certificate, dated the day before the Sale, stating that the pony is fit to travel. The pony must only be vetted the day immediately prior to the Sale. If no such certificate is received by the Auctioneer, the pony must not be permitted to go forward for sale. No ponies over 20 years of age will be accepted for sale.
- 16. Any mare or filly that has been running with an entire male that has not passed the SPSBS Voluntary Vetting Examination (VVE) will not be accepted for sale.
- 17. If a mare is in foal, it is assumed it is to a stallion registered with SPS- BS. The covering stallion's name and registration number and date(s) of covering must be clearly stated on the entry form. As from 1 January 2022 all foals registered with the SPS-BS must have a DNA profile of the sire completed. Buyers need to be aware of this when purchasing an in foal mare.
- 18. In the interests of welfare, lactating mares without a foal at foot will not be accepted for sale, nor will mares due to foal within eight weeks or less of the date of the sale. Mares 3 years old or younger with a foal at foot will not be accepted for sale. Fillies younger than 3 years old that have been running with a stallion will not be accepted for sale.
- 19. Entry forms MUST be completed in full or they will not be accepted.
- 20. Entry fees are detailed on the sale entry form.
- 21. If ponies are catalogued, as "for sale due to stud dispersal", it is assumed that the ponies will be sold and not taken home unsold.
- 22. In the interests of welfare, working ponies of four years old or over only may be clipped on the body only.
- 23. Passports & microchips for ponies will be checked at the sale. Vendors must ensure they contact a "checker" immediately upon arrival at the Mart to have their ponies' passports checked prior to handing your passports to the auctioneer's office. It is the responsibility of the vendor or any person acting on their behalf to ensure that this is carried out.
- 24. A pony will not be permitted to be presented for sale unless a checked passport has been received by the Auctioneer's Office prior to the Sale. The Passport must then be passed to the new owner for the onward journey.
- 25. TRANSFER FEES Please note that it is now the responsibility of NEW OWNERS to pay the transfer fees for ponies they have purchased. The same rates apply for both members & non-members. All transfer fees are £20 per pony. THESE TRANSFER FEES WILL BE CHARGED ON TOP OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF ANY PONY YOU BUY.
- 26. VALUE ADDED TAX Where ponies are sold from consignors who are VAT registered, VAT will be added to the Auctioneer's knock down price.

- 27. If a pony is to be exported, the buyer is responsible for arranging an International Pony Movement Certificate (IPMC) and a fee of £50 is payable to the SPS-BS. Export fees and arrangements will be in addition to this and are the responsibility of the buyer.
- 28. The Society reserves the right to randomly DNA test ponies which would involve taking a hair sample.
- 29. The sale show is affiliated to the SPS-BS and will be judged under their rules. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to familiarise themselves with these rules prior to entering.
- 30. Entire males aged 2 years and over must be bitted and it is recommended that they display a stallion badge on their bridle both in the Show, Sale Ring and when outside their pens.
- 31. All 4 year old and over entire males must be in possession of their VVE to be entered into the showing classes, entire males 4 years old and over without their VVE cannot be shown.
- 32. Buyers are reminded that any ponies they purchase are at their risk at the fall of the hammer. No undertaking of the Auctioneers or their servants to take charge of any lots after the sale or to forward them to their destination shall be held to impose upon the Auctioneers any legal obligation. Whilst evert effort is made by the organisers to ensure that the information given regarding pedigree, ownership, detail of colour and date of birth is correct, the responsibility remains with the prospective buyer to verify these details. Liability for errors and omissions will not be accepted by the Society or Auctioneers.
- 33. It is good practice to isolate any newly acquired animals for at least two weeks before mixing with other equines or attending any events.
- 34. Children aged 14 years and under must wear a hard hat conforming to the current British Safety standards both in-hand & ridden. For health & safety purposes handlers/exhibitors must not kneel whether in the show ring or sale ring.
- 35. If the vendor is not present in person, a representative must be nominated in advance who will be responsible for the ponies.
- 36. The Parade/Sale may be videoed/photographed for Promotional Purposes.
- 37. The PBSA Reserve the right to refuse entry.

# **Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme**

The abolition, in 2005, of the Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society (SPS-BS) Stallion Assessment Scheme left no official programme in operation for selection of a stallion displaying good conformation and breed characteristics nor, perhaps more importantly, the rejection of one with bad.

Fearing that this could possibly contribute to a deterioration of breed standards, Shetland, under the Pony Breeders of Shetland Association (PBSA), established a Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme of its own. The aim of this scheme is to do what we can to ensure that, at least, the quality and purity of the breed is maintained and, at best, continues to improve.

This scheme is voluntary and is open to anyone who wishes to put their ponies forward. The scheme is the property of the Pony Breeders of Shetland Association.

This scheme gives breeders the opportunity to have their stallions and Mares fully evaluated by three senior SPSBS Panel judges as well as the SPS-BS VVE. The VVE in operation under the SPS-BS, which is in fact a compulsory part of our stallion scheme, is not impinged upon nor affected in any way by the PBSA Shetland Pony Evaluation Scheme. Mares are evaluated using the same criteria.

The scheme runs annually in Shetland and is usually on the last weekend of July.

She is a fantastic broodmare, carefully chosen as the foundation mare of the Happyhansel Stud. Eynhallow Cassie comes to call, is easy to catch, groom, wash, load and work with. She is used to children, up to date with feet and worming and a full dental report can be sent on to prospective buyers. Cassie would be an asset to any stud, she has produced another strong foal this year, who has been sold privately, without any issues. She has not been running with a stallion.

Shiraz is a sweet 2 year old filly with a super pedigree. Very friendly and easy to handle. Her dam has done well for us in the show ring, having achieved Reserve Miniature Ring Champion at the Viking Show as a 3 year old, last year being Reserve Senior Champion at the Viking Show and 2nd at the SPSBS Breed Show in a class of 20 mares. Breckenlea Savanna also achieved a Gold Award at the SPES, as did Gott Surrey and Kerswell Starbuck all who feature in Shiraz's pedigree. Her sire Kerswell Bonanza achieved a Silver Award at the SPES. She is only for sale as she is maturing too small for our stud, currently measuring approximately 30". She has not been running with a stallion.
